



Lilac Pathway

What is a pathway?: A pathway is a trail located within the public roadway or right-of-way, which runs parallel to the road. Because of their proximity to roads, pathways serve as alternative transportation facilities and, therefore, are eligible for partial funding from the County's annual gas tax revenue.

ACCESS: From Hwy 67 (Main Street) in Ramona, west on Hwy 78 (10th Street), right on Haverford Road, and left on Lilac Road.

LENGTH AND ELEVATION: 1 mile one way; 1480' to 1580'.

DESCRIPTION: From the intersection of Haverford Road and Lilac Road, the pathway runs along the east side of the road. Just past Rancho Trails Road, the pathway shifts to the west side of Lilac Road. At this time, there is no trail connection at the end of Lilac.

RECOMMENDED USES: This pathway is suitable for all categories of nonmotorized recreational and transportation uses.
