



## Pine Pathway

**What is a pathway?** *A pathway is a trail located within the public roadway or right-of-way, which runs parallel to the road. Because of their proximity to roads, pathways serve as alternative transportation facilities and, therefore, are eligible for partial funding from the County's annual gas tax revenue.*

**ACCESS:** From Hwy 67 (Main Street) in Ramona, west on Hwy 78 (10<sup>th</sup> Street), right on Haverford Road, and left on Pine Street. No formal staging area exists, but there is a small wide spot on the right hand side at the end of Pine Street where it turns onto Katherine View that serves as staging for the time being.

**LENGTH AND ELEVATION:** 1.5 miles one way; 1490' to 1610'.

**DESCRIPTION:** From the intersection of Haverford Road and Pine Street, the pathway runs north along both sides of the road for 0.5 mile. Where the road narrows for a culvert, the pathway continues only on the west side of Pine. At the end of Pine, the pathway turns left along Kathrine View Way and then connects with trails in Cleveland National Forest.

**RECOMMENDED USES:** This pathway is suitable for all categories of non-motorized recreational and transportation uses.
